Under the authority of the Prerogative of the Crown, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is pleased to appoint the Honourable Nathaniel S. Noel, as a Commissioner to define and to draw the boundaries of the electoral Districts into which the House of Assembly is divided, in accordance with the following direction:


1. Four of the Districts shall be entirely within Labrador, as recommended by the Electoral Boundaries Commission in its final report of June 1994, with one consisting of the communities located in the area generally to the north of Lake Melville, from Rigolet to Nain, whose population is mainly aboriginal; another consisting of the communities on the southern coast of Labrador between Sandwich Bay and L'Anse au Clair; another consisting of those communities located in western Labrador and another consisting of the Town of Churchill Falls and those communities in the Lake Melville area of Labrador.

2. The quotient for each of the other Districts of the Province, subject to the exceptions hereinafter set out, shall be determined, using the population figures from the 1991 Census, by subtracting the population of the present Torngat (2,984) and Eagle River (5,133) Districts from that of the Province (568,474), and dividing the resulting total (560,357) by the lowest number that would enable the two remaining Labrador districts to fall within plus or minus 10% of the quotient if they were divided equally.

3. The Commissioner may recommend the creation of one District (or two Districts if the Commissioner is of the opinion that two Districts would enable more reasonable transportation access) located in whole or in part on that portion of the southwest coast of the Island of Newfoundland from Petites to Rencontre East inclusive which has communities not connected by road, the population of which District or Districts may depart by 25% less from the quotient, but no such district shall extend east of Long Harbour River, Fortune Bay and at least 50% of the population of any such district shall be located in that area of the southwest coast described above.
4. Subject to the above, the boundaries of the remaining Districts shall be such as to ensure that the population of no District shall vary from the quotient by more than 10%.
5. The Commissioner shall not hold hearings, but may rely upon the evidence taken by, and the report of, the Electoral Boundaries Commission of June 1994.
6. The Commissioner shall make his report to the Minister of Justice by April 30, 1995.

Part 2.

Analysis of Minute-in-Council MC 95-0153

The Commissioner is instructed to divide Labrador into four electoral districts consisting of communities:

1. North of Lake Melville, from Rigolet to Nain;
2. On the southern coast of Labrador between Sandwich Bay and L'Anse au Clair;
3. In western Labrador; and,
4. In the Lake Melville area and of the Town of Churchill Falls.

The minute gives the method by which the number and population of districts, other than those in Labrador, are to be determined. In making that determination, the 1991 Census must be used. The method is:

1.	Use 1991 Census total	568,474
2.	Less: Torngat Mountains	2,984

3. Divide 560,357 by the lowest number that enables the two remaining Labrador districts to fall within plus or minus 10% of the quotient, if they were divided equally.
4. The total population of the two remaining Labrador districts, Menihek and Naskaupi, is 22,252. If that total population were divided equally the resulting populations would be 11,126.
5. Dividing 560,357 by the lowest number that will enable 11,126 to fall within plus or minus 10% of the quotient, that is, 46, yields a quotient of 12,181.
6. The total population of the province, 568,474, less the population of Labrador (568,474 - 2,984 - 5,133 - 22,252) 538,105, divided by the quotient, 12,181, enables forty-four electoral districts in the Island of Newfoundland, for a total of forty-eight in the province.

The minute permits one district to be located in whole or in part on the southwest coast of the Island of Newfoundland from Petites to Roncontre East, inclusive, which has communities unconnected by road (or two districts if that would enable more reasonable transportation access), but no such district shall extend east of Long Harbour River, Fortune Bay. A departure of minus twenty-five per cent is permitted, if at least fifty per cent of the population of the district is located within the area described.

Subject to the instruction with respect to districts in Labrador and along the southwest coast, the populations of all other districts must not vary from the quotient by more than ten per cent.

There will be no hearings. The evidence taken by, and the report of, the Electoral Boundaries Commission of June 1994 may be used by the commissioner. A report shall be made to the Minister of Justice by April 30, 1995.

Part 3.

Principles

The purpose of dividing a province into electoral districts was considered by the Supreme Court of Canada in Reference re: Provincial Boundaries [1991] S.C.R. 1. It is to give effective representation to the whole population. Effective representation comprehends the idea of one having a voice in the deliberations of government through an elected representative as well as the right to bring grievances and concerns to the attention of one's elected representative.

Adherence to the principle of parity of voting power is important, however, it is not paramount. Effective representation requires more. It requires that factors like geography, community history, community interests, and minority representation be taken into account. This has always been the case in Newfoundland, and it is implicit in the minute-in-council which contains conditions permitting departure from the quotient to the extent stated.

The existing districts reflect the factors referred to by the Court, but changing populations have resulted in disparity of voting power to the degree shown in Part 4. In recommending the proposed electoral districts, the principles mentioned have been kept in mind. In particular, small communities have not been divided, and the dictates of geography have been observed. This has led to departure from the quotient where necessary.

Part 6.

Descriptions of forty-eight proposed electoral districts.

AVALON CENTER

The District of Avalon Center shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northern shore line of Bay de Grave, west of Salmon Cove Point;

Thence running in a westerly direction to a point of intersection with the Geodetic Control Station "81G2193", south of the community of Birch Hills;

Thence running west to its intersection with the eastern boundary of the District of Bay de Verde;

Thence running south along the eastern boundary of the District of Bay de Verde and the eastern boundary of the District of Bellevue to a point of intersection with the center line of North River and the shore line of The Pond That Feeds The Brook;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of a road that leads to the community of Blaketown (Route 80) and the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of the road which leads to Argentia (Route 100);

Thence running south to a point of intersection with the Parallel of $47^{\circ}18'$ North Latitude and the Meridian of $53^{\circ}34'$ West Longitude;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway and the center line of Salmonier Line (Route 90);

Thence running in a general northerly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of an unnamed brook which extends between Harbour Main Pond and Southwest Pond;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Maloney's River and the shore line of Harbour Main Pond;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of a bridge at the mouth of North Arm River;

Thence running along the center line of the said river in a general northerly direction to its intersection with the shore line of North Arm;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the shore lines of Holyrood Bay, Gasters Bay, Colliers Bay and Bay de Grave to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Roaches Line, Emerald Vale, Salmonier Line, Mackinsons, Marysvale, Colliers, Conception Harbour, Avondale, Chapel's Cove, Lakeview, Harbour Main, Brigus Junction, South River, Clarke's Beach, North River, Goulds Road, Juniper Stump, Turks Water, Cupids, Brigus, Georgetown, Whitbourne, Markland, and that part of the Town of Holyrood as described above.

BAIE VERTE

The District of Baie Verte shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at Shale Point, White Bay;

Thence running south along the eastern boundary of the District of Humber Valley to its intersection with the Parallel of 49°33' North Latitude;

Thence running along the said Parallel of 49°33' North Latitude to its intersection with the western shore line of Halls Bay;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the shore line of Halls Bay to Halls Bay Head;

Thence running in a general northwesterly and northeasterly direction along the shore line of Notre Dame Bay to a point of land known as South Bill;

Thence running along the shore lines of Confusion Bay and Baie Verte in a general westerly direction to Partridge Point;

Thence running along the shore line of White Bay in a general southwesterly direction to the point of beginning, together with Little Bay Islands, Gull Island, Horse Islands and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of La Scie, Shoe Cove, Tilt Cove, Round Harbour, Snooks Arm, Nippers Harbour, Smith's Harbour, Burlington, Middle Arm, Purbecks Cove, Westport, Seal Cove, Wild Cove, Fleur de Lys, Coachman's Cove, Baie Verte, Mings Bight, Pacquet, Woodstock, Harbour Round, Brent's Cove, Harry's Harbour, Jackson's Cove, Langdon's Cove, Nicky's Nose Cove, Rattling Brook, Silverdale, King's Point, Beachside, Little Bay, St. Patricks, and Little Bay Islands.

BAY DE VERDE

The District of Bay de Verde shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the center line of Spout Cove Brook and the western shore line of Conception Bay, northeast of the community of Perry's Cove;

Thence running along the center line of Spout Cove Brook to its intersection with the center line of Route 70;

Thence running west to its intersection with the center line of Route 74, which extends between the communities of Heart's Content and Victoria;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of a road which extends between the communities of Carbonear and Heart's Delight, and a line drawn north from the intersection of the shore line of The Pond That Feeds The Brook and the center line of North River;

Thence running south along the said line to its intersection with the Parallel of $47^{\circ}32'$ North Latitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of $47^{\circ}32'$ North Latitude to a point of intersection with the Meridian of $53^{\circ}32'$ West Longitude;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to its intersection with the northern boundary of the fish packing plant situated between the communities of Dildo South and Broad Cove;

Thence running west to its intersection with the shore line at Dildo Arm;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the eastern shore line of Trinity Bay to Grates Point;

Thence running in a general southeasterly and southwesterly direction along the western shore line of Conception Bay to the point of beginning, together with Baccalieu Island and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Daniel's Cove, Caplin Cove, Low Point, Bay de Verde, Red Head Cove, Grates Cove, Old Perlican, Lead Cove, Turks Cove, Sibley's Cove, Brownsdale, New Melbourne, New Chelsea, Hants Harbour, Winterton, New Perlican, Heart's Content, Heart's Desire, Islington, Heart's Delight, Broad Cove, Cavendish, Whiteway, Green's Harbour, Hopeall, New Harbour, Adam's Cove, Kingston, Small Point, Broad Cove, Blackhead, Western Bay, Ochre Pit Cove, Northern Bay, Long Beach, Gull Island, Burnt Point, Jobs Cove, Lower Island Cove, and Dildo.

BAY OF ISLANDS

The District of Bay of Islands shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the center line of Rope Cove Brook and the eastern shore line of the Gulf of St. Lawrence;

Thence running east to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 48°55' North Latitude and the Meridian of 58° West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of 58° West Longitude to its intersection with the center line of St. Mary's Brook;

Thence running along the center line of St. Mary's Brook in a general northerly direction to its intersection with the southern shore line of Humber Arm;

Thence running in a general easterly direction along the southern shore line of Humber Arm to its intersection with the center line of the Humber River;

Thence running along the center line of the Humber River to its intersection with the center line of an unnamed river, which extends from Wild Cove Lake and flows into Humber River;

Thence running north to its intersection with the Parallel of 49° North Latitude;

Thence running east along the said Parallel of 49° North Latitude to its intersection with the western shore line of Humber River;

Thence running along the western shore line of the said river in a general northeasterly direction to its intersection with the shore line of Deer Lake;

Thence extending to the western shore line of Deer Lake and continuing in a general northeasterly direction to its intersection with the southwestern boundary of the District of Humber Valley;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Gregory River and the eastern shore line of the Gulf of St. Lawrence;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the eastern shore line of the Gulf of St. Lawrence to North Head;

Thence running along the northern and southern shore lines of the Bay of Islands to South Head;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the eastern shore line of the Gulf of St. Lawrence to the point of beginning, together with Wood's Island, Pearl Island and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Lark Harbour, Wood's Island, York Harbour, Halfway Point, Frenchmen's Cove, John's Beach, Mount Moriah, Cox's Cove, McIvers, Gillams, Hughes Brook, Irishtown-Summerside, Meadows, and part of the City of Corner Brook as described above.

BELLEVUE

The District of Bellevue shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of land known as St. Jones Head on the western shore line of Trinity Bay;

Thence running west to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 47°58' North Latitude and the Meridian of 55° West Longitude;

Thence running along the eastern boundary of the District of Ramea - Bay d'Espoir, south along the said Meridian of 55° West Longitude to its intersection with the western shore line of Long Harbour;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction along the said shore line to its intersection with a point of land known as Long Harbour Point, Fortune Bay;

Thence running along the shore line of Fortune Bay in a general northeasterly and southwesterly direction to a point of land known as Grand John Point, southwest of the community of St. Bernard's;

Thence running in an easterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Route 210 and the center line of Route 212, which leads to the community of Jacques Fontaine;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 47°30' North Latitude and the Meridian of 54°30' West Longitude;

Thence running east along the said Parallel of 47°30' North Latitude to its intersection with the Meridian of 54° West Longitude;

Thence running south along the said Meridian of 54° West Longitude to its intersection with the prolongation of a line extending west from Long Harbour Head;

Thence running east along the said prolongation to Long Harbour Head, northwest of the community of Ship Harbour;

Thence running east to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 47°23' North Latitude and the Meridian of 53°48' West Longitude;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 47°18' North Latitude and the Meridian of 53°34' West Longitude;

Thence running north to a point of intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway and the center line of the road leading to Argentinia (Route 100);

Thence running in an easterly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of a road leading to the community of Blaketown (Route 80);

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the shore line of The Pond That Feeds The Brook and the center line of North River;

Thence running north along the western boundary of the District of Avalon Center to its intersection with the Parallel of 47°32' North Latitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 47°32' North Latitude to its intersection with the Meridian of 53°32' West Longitude;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to its intersection with the northern boundary of a fish packing plant, situated between the communities of Dildo South and Broad Cove on the eastern shore line of Trinity Bay;

Thence running in a general northwesterly and northeasterly direction along the shore line of Trinity Bay to the point of beginning, together with Woody Island, Bar Haven Island and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

BONAVISTA NORTH

The District of Bonavista North shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the Parallel of 48°54' North Latitude and the western shore line of Lockers Bay, south of a bridge which spans the western most portion of the said bay;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 48°54' North Latitude to its intersection with the eastern boundary of the District of Gander;

Thence running along the said boundary, due north to its intersection with the Parallel of 49°03' North Latitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 49°03' North Latitude to its intersection with the center line of Route 330, the said road extends between the Trans Canada Highway and the community of Gander Bay;

Thence running north to a point of intersection with the southern shore line of Dog Bay and the center line of an unnamed river;

Thence running east to its intersection with the western shore line of Gander Bay;

Thence running in a general southerly and northerly direction along the shore lines of Gander Bay and Fredericton Harbour, to a point of land known as Noggin Point;

Thence running in a general easterly direction along the shore line of Rocky Bay and Aspen Cove to Ladle Point;

Thence running in a general easterly direction along the shore lines of Ladle Cove, Ragged Harbour and Muddy Hole to a point of land known as Muddy Point;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the shore line to North Bill, north of the community of Cape Freels North;

Thence running along the shore line in a general southerly direction to Shoe Cove Point;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the shore lines of Indian Bay, Trinity Bay and Lockers Bay to the point of beginning, together with Barber's Island, Pools Island,

Greenspond Island, Lewis Island, Silver Fox Island and all other islands adjacent thereto, with the exception of those islands contained in the District of Twillingate - Fogo;

BONAVISTA SOUTH

The District of Bonavista South shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of land known as South Head, south of the community of Melrose, Trinity Bay;

Thence running in a westerly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 48°28' North Latitude and the Meridian of 53°21' West Longitude;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 48°18' North Latitude and the Meridian of 53°56' West Longitude, the said point being more precisely situated south of the community of Morley's Siding and north of Gull Pond;

Thence running along the eastern boundary of the District of Terra Nova, in a northerly direction to a point of intersection with the shore line of Northwest Pond and the center line of Stagg Brook;

Thence running along the western shore line of Burin Inlet to its intersection with the western shore line of Salt Pond;

Thence running along the western shore line of Salt Pond to its intersection with a point on the northern shore line of the said pond;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of a bridge which spans Southwest Arm and the center line of Route 210 leading to the Town of Marystown;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

The District of Columbus Drive shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the center line of Topsail Road and the center line of James Lane;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the center line of James Lane to its intersection with the center line of Mercer's Lane;

Thence running along the center line of Mercer's Lane to its intersection with the center line of Blackmarsh Road;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the center line of Blackmarsh Road to its intersection with the center line of Canada Drive;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the center line of Canada Drive to its intersection with the center line of Burgeo Street;

Thence running along the center line of Topsail Road in a general easterly direction to the point of beginning.

Thence running in a southerly direction along the center line of Long Pond to its intersection with the center line of Conway Brook;

Thence running along the center line of Conway Brook in a general southerly direction to its intersection with the shore line of Big Pond;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway and the center line of Route 61 (Foxtrap Access Road);

Thence running along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway in a general southwesterly and northwesterly direction to its intersection with the center line of an unnamed brook which extends between Harbour Main Pond and Southwest Pond;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Maloney's River and the shore line of Harbour Main Pond;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the western shore line of the Bay of Exploits to a point of land known as Wigwam Point, located southeast of the community of Peterview;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Rattling Brook;

Thence running along the center line of Rattling Brook in a general southeasterly direction to the point of beginning, together with all islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the Meridian of 55° West Longitude and the northern boundary of the District of Ramea - Bay d'Espoir;

Thence running west along the said boundary to its intersection with the Meridian of $55^{\circ}18'$ West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of $55^{\circ}18'$ West Longitude to its intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the Parallel of $49^{\circ}03'$ North Latitude;

Thence running along the southern boundary of the District of Lewisporte, east along the said Parallel of $49^{\circ}03'$ North Latitude to its intersection with a line drawn due north from the eastern most point of Gander Lake;

Thence running due south along the said line to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Glenwood, Appleton, Gander, and Benton.

GRAND BANK

The District of Grand Bank shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of a bridge which spans Southwest Arm and the center line of Route 210 leading to the Town of Marystown;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to its intersection with the northern shore line of Salt Pond;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the western shore line of Salt Pond to its intersection with the shore line of Burin Inlet;

Thence running along the western shore line of Burin Inlet to its intersection with a point of land known as Spoon Point, southeast of the community of Epworth;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the western shore line of Placentia Bay to its intersection with a point of land known as Long Point, southeast of the community of Corbin;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the shore line of the Burin Peninsula to its intersection with a point of land known as Dantzic Point;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the shore line of Fortune Bay to the point of beginning, together with Allan's Island, Little Burin Island and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running west along the said boundary to its intersection with the Meridian of 57°30' West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of 57°30' West Longitude to its intersection with the northern shore line of Grand Lake;

Thence running along the said shore line in a general northeasterly direction to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 49°04' North Latitude and a Meridian of 57°32' West Longitude and crossing the Trans Canada Highway 1000m, southwest of the center of a bridge across Pynn's Brook;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the western shore line of Grand Lake and the Parallel of 49° North Latitude;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the western shore line of Grand Lake to its intersection with the Parallel of 48°55' North Latitude;

Thence running west, along the Parallel of 48°55' North Latitude to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Massey Drive, Steady Brook, Humber Village, Little Rapids, Pasadena, and that part of the City of Corner Brook as described above.

HUMBER VALLEY

Thence running north along the said line to Shale Point, White Bay;

Thence running in a general southwesterly and northeasterly direction along the shore lines of White Bay and the Great Northern Peninsula to Canada Head, south of the community of Englee;

Thence running along the center lines of Canada Bay, Chimney Bay and Northeast Brook to its intersection with the center line of Route 433;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 51°04' North Latitude and the Meridian of 56°22' West Longitude;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 49°30' North Latitude and the Meridian of 57°27' West Longitude;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Southeast Brook and the shore line of Southeast Arm;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the southern shore line of Bonne Bay, to Western Head;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the shore line of the Gulf of St. Lawrence to the point of beginning, together with all islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running east to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running in an easterly direction to Woody Cove;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the eastern shore line of the Avalon Peninsula to a point on the shore line of Empty Basket Cove;

Thence running west to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 47°29' North Latitude and the Meridian of 52°45' West Longitude, the said point being known as Turtle Hill;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of an unnamed river, which extends between Fourth Pond and Third Pond and the center line of a road extending between Route 10 and the community of Petty Harbour;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the center line of the said road to its intersection with the center line of Route 10;

The District of Labrador South shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection with the boundary of the Province of Newfoundland and the Province of Quebec, near Blanc Sablon, and the northern shore of the Strait of Belle Isle;

Thence running north along the said boundary to its intersection with the Parallel of 52° North Latitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 52° North Latitude to its intersection with the Meridian of 57° 37' West Longitude;

Thence running along the eastern boundary of the District of Lake Melville, north along the said Meridian of 57° 37' West Longitude to its intersection with Flatwater Point, located on the southern shore of Groswater Bay;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the southern shoreline of Groswater Bay to Fish Cove Point;

Thence running in a general southeasterly, southerly and southwesterly direction along the eastern shore line of Labrador to the point of beginning, together with Belle Isle, Grady Island, Island of Ponds, Square Islands and all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Cartwright, Charlottetown, Mary's Harbour, Port Hope Simpson, St. Lewis, Black Tickle, Domino, Lodge Bay, Norman Bay, Paradise River, Pinsent's Arm, William's Harbour, Red Bay, Pinware, West St. Modeste, Capstan Island, L'Anse au Loup, L'Anse Amour, Forteau, and L'Anse au Clair.

LABRADOR WEST

The District of Labrador West shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the Parallel of 53° North Latitude and the Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude to its intersection with the boundary separating the Province of Newfoundland and the Province of Quebec;

Thence running along the said boundary in a general westerly and southeasterly direction to its intersection with the Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Labrador City and Wabush.

LAKE MELVILLE

The District of Lake Melville shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection with the Parallel of 52° North Latitude and the Meridian of 57° 37' West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said Meridian of 57° 37' West Longitude to its intersection with Flatwater Point, located on the southern shore of Groswater Bay;

Thence running in a general westerly, easterly and westerly direction along the southern shoreline of Hamilton Inlet and Lake Melville, to a point of land known as Rabbit Point;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 54° North Latitude and the Meridian of 60° West Longitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 54° North Latitude to its intersection with the Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude;

Thence running south along the said Meridian of 64°20' West Longitude to its intersection with the boundary of the Province of Newfoundland and the Province of Quebec;

Thence running along the said boundary in a general easterly, westerly, southerly and easterly direction to the point of beginning,

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Churchill Falls, Happy Valley-Goose Bay, North West River, Sheshashit, and Mud Lake.

LA POILE

The District of La Poile shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at Cape Ray, northwest of the community of Port aux Basques;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to its intersection with the southeastern corner of Barachois Pond Provincial Park;

Thence running northerly and westerly along the said boundary to its intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running in a general northerly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of Southwest Brook, flowing into the St. George's River;

Thence running east to a point of intersection with the Meridian of 57°30' West Longitude;

Thence running south along the said Meridian of 57°30' West Longitude to its intersection with the shore line of the southwest coast, east of the community of Burgeo;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the center line of Pitts Memorial Drive to its intersection with the center line of Commonwealth Avenue;

Thence running along the center line of Commonwealth Avenue in a general northerly direction to its intersection with the center line of Heavy Tree Road;

Thence running along the center line of Heavy Tree Road to its intersection with the center line of Brookfield Road;

Thence running along the center line of Brookfield Road to its intersection with the center line of the City of Mount Pearl Municipal Boundary (1991);

Thence running along the said boundary in a general northwesterly direction to its intersection with the center line of the northern branch of Fling's Brook;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the said brook to its intersection with the center line of Ruth Avenue;

Thence running along the center line of Ruth Avenue in a general southerly direction to the point of beginning.

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the Parallel of $47^{\circ} 18'$ North Latitude and the Meridian of $53^{\circ} 34'$ West Longitude;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway and the center line of Route 90 (Salmonier Line);

Thence running in a southwesterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Route 10 and the center line of a road which extends between Route 10 and the community of St. Shotts;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point of land known as Baker Head, located on the western shore line of Trepassey Bay;

Thence running in a general southwesterly, northerly, southwesterly and northeasterly direction along the shore lines of Trepassey Bay, St. Mary's Bay and Placentia Bay to the point of beginning, together with all islands adjacent thereto;

Thence running in a westerly direction along the center line of Prince Rupert Drive to its intersection with the center line of Boland Drive;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the center line of Boland Drive to its intersection with the center line of West Street;

Thence running south to its intersection with the shore line of St. George's Bay;

Thence running in a general westerly and northeasterly direction to Long Point, Port au Port Bay;

Thence running in a general southwesterly, easterly and northerly direction along the shore line of Port au Port Bay to the point of beginning;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running in an easterly direction to a point of intersection with the shore line of Riverhead Long Pond and the center line of an unnamed river flowing from the said pond into First Gully;

Thence running in a southeasterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Neddie Smith's Pond;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to Black Point on the eastern shore line of Harbour Grace;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the eastern shore line of Harbour Grace to Feather Point;

Thence running in a general southeasterly and southwesterly direction along the shore line of St. George's Bay to Grebes Head;

Thence running in a general southeasterly direction along the shore line of Cabot Strait to Cape Ray;

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to its intersection with the southeastern corner of Barachois Pond Provincial Park boundary;

Thence running northerly and westerly along the said boundary to its intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of Southwest Brook;

Thence running east to a point of intersection with the Meridian of 57°30' West Longitude;

Thence running north along the said meridian of 57°30' West Longitude to its intersection with the northern shore line of Grand Lake;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the shore line of Grand Lake to its intersection with the center line of Grand Lake Brook;

Thence running in a northwesterly direction to the point of beginning, together with all islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Thence running along the said boundary to a point of land known as South Head;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the shore line of St. John's Bay and Cape Bay to a point of land known as Cape Spear;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the shore line to Woody Cove;

Thence running in a westerly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Blackhead Road and the center line of a road leading to Petty Harbour - Maddox Cove;

Thence running along the center line of Blackhead Road in a general northerly direction to its intersection with the center line of an unnamed brook extending between Bentley Pond and Leamy's Pond;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

TRINITY NORTH

Thence running westerly to a point of intersection with the shore line of Virginia Lake;

Thence running along the southern shore line of Virginia Lake in a general westerly direction to its intersection with the center line of Virginia River, located near Rigolet Crescent;

Thence running along the center line of Kenmount Road to its intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway in a general southwesterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Pitts Memorial Drive;

Thence running along the center line of Pitts Memorial Drive in a general southeasterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Ruth Avenue;

Thence running along the center line of Ruth Avenue to its intersection with the center line of an unnamed brook which extends between Michener Avenue and Glendale Avenue;

Thence running along the center line of the said river to its intersection with the center line of Waterford River;

Thence running along the center line of Waterford River in a general southeasterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Commonwealth Avenue;

Thence running along the center line of Commonwealth Avenue in a general southeasterly direction to its intersection with the center line of the northern branch of Flings Brook;

Thence running along the center line of Flings Brook in a general easterly direction to its intersection with the City of Mount Pearl Municipal Boundary (1991);

Thence running in a northeasterly direction to a point of intersection with the center line of Waterford River and the center line of an unnamed brook, more precisely situated south of Dunn's Road;

Thence running in a general westerly direction along the center line of the Waterford River to its intersection with the center line of Dunn's Road;

Thence running along the center line of Dunn's Road in a general northerly direction to its intersection with the center line of Topsail Road;

Thence running in a general easterly direction along the center line of Topsail Road to its intersection with the center line of Burgeo Street;

Thence running along the center line of Burgeo Street to its intersection with the center line of Canada Drive;

Thence running along the center line of Canada Drive to its intersection with the center line of Blackmarsh Road;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the center line of Blackmarsh Road to its intersection with the City of St. John's Municipal Boundary (1991);

Thence running along the said boundary in a general northwesterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Wyatt Boulevard;

Thence running along the center line of Wyatt Boulevard to the point of beginning.

Note: This District shall include that part of the City of Mount Pearl and the City of St. John's described above.

WINDSOR - SPRINGDALE

The District of Windsor - Springdale shall consist of and include all that part of the Province of Newfoundland bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection with the western shore line of Halls Bay and the Parallel of 49°33' North Latitude;

Thence running west along the said Parallel of 49°33' North Latitude to its intersection with a line drawn south from Shale Point on the eastern shore line of White Bay;

Thence running south along the said line to its intersection with the Parallel of 49° North Latitude;

Thence running east along the said Parallel of 49° North Latitude to its intersection with the western shore line of Aspen Pond;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the said shore line to its intersection with the center line of Aspen Brook;

Thence running in a general southerly direction along the center line of Aspen Brook to a point of intersection with the center line of the Trans Canada Highway;

Thence running in a general easterly direction along the center line of the Trans Canada Highway to its intersection with the center line of Victoria Street, located in the Town of Grand Falls - Windsor;

Thence running in a general northerly direction along the center line of Victoria Street to its intersection with the center line of an abandoned railway line;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the center line of the abandoned railway line to its intersection with the prolongation of Wheeler's Avenue;

Thence running along the said prolongation in a general northeasterly direction to its intersection with the center line of Wheeler's Avenue;

Thence running in a general northwesterly direction along the center line of Wheeler's Avenue to its intersection with the center line of Earle Street;

Thence running in a general southwesterly direction along the center line of Earle Street to its intersection with the center line of Caribou Road;

Thence running in a general northeasterly direction along the center line of Caribou Road to its intersection with the center line of Princess Place;

Thence running north to a point of intersection with the Parallel of 49° North Latitude;

Thence running east along the said Parallel of 49° North Latitude to its intersection with the Meridian of 55°35' West Longitude;

Thence running along the western boundary of the District of Exploits, north along the said Meridian of 55°35' West Longitude to its intersection with the eastern shore line of Badger Bay;

Thence running along the shore lines of Badger Bay, Roberts Arm and Halls Bay to the point of beginning, together with Triton Island, Pilley's Island, Long Island, Sunday Cove Island all other islands adjacent thereto;

All geographic coordinates being scaled and referenced to the Universal Transverse Mercator Map Projection and the North American Datum of 1983.

Note: This District shall include the communities of Springdale, South Brook, Roberts Arm, Pilley's Island, Triton, Brighton, Port Anson, Miles Cove, Lushes Bight, Beaumont, Sheppardville, and that part of the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor as described above.
